PROJECT LIFESAVER ENROLLMENT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Suffolk County Sheriff's Office Project Lifesaver Program is a countywide emergency response locator service capable of finding individuals diagnosed with cognitive impairments which may cause them to wander and become lost.

The enrollment application is designed for custodial caregivers to complete on behalf of the applicant who will be enrolled in the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office Project Lifesaver Program. By submitting the enrollment application to the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office Project Lifesaver Bureau, the applicant will be considered for participation in the program.

Participation Criteria

- The application must be completed and submitted by the legal, primary family member/caregiver (authorized representative) for the applicant with the physician-confirmed cognitive impairments diagnosis.
- The applicant must reside in the County of Suffolk with a primary caregiver.

Client Photograph

- A recent, digital applicant headshot must be submitted via e-mail to lifesaver@suffolkcountyny.gov. Please include the applicant's name in the e-mail.

Headshot Guidelines

- Head should be directly facing the camera
- Photo should capture from slightly above the top of the applicant's hair to the middle of his/her chest.
- Eyes should be open and looking at the camera.
- Eyeglasses should be worn if normally used by the applicant.

Upon receipt of the completed enrollment application, personnel from the Project Lifesaver Bureau will review the application. If the application is approved, the caregiver will be contacted to schedule an appointment with Project Lifesaver Bureau personnel. During the appointment, the caregiver will receive the transmitter along with instructions pertaining to transmitter maintenance.
